UNIT TITLE: Licence to operate a boom – type elevated work platform (boom length 11 metres or more)

DURATION: 2 Days

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Must be 18 years age or over

ASSESSMENT METHOD: As per WorkSafe Victoria requirements the licence assessment encompasses a knowledge, performance and calculations assessment

OBTAINING YOUR LICENCE: The licence to perform High Risk Work is issued by Worksafe Victoria.

When the assessor deems you competent, you are issued with a Notice of Assessment which you must lodge at a Post Office within 60 days to obtain your license from Worksafe Victoria.
