SCAFFOLDING, DOGMAN, RIGGING, NON-SLEWING CRANE, ELEVATED WORK PLATFORM, MATERIALS HOIST, FORKLIFT

BASIC SCAFFOLDING (SB) - 5 DAYS

LOCATION: Werribee or Onsite

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Plan, erect, inspect and dismantle scaffold • Set up fall arrest systems, including safety nets • Interpret basic scaffolding plans
- Identify equipment faults • Understand load capabilities

CPCCLSF2001A Licence to erect, alter and dismantle scaffolding basic level

INTERMEDIATE SCAFFOLDING (SI) - 4 DAYS

LOCATION: Werribee or Onsite

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Erect, alter and dismantle tube and coupler scaffolding • Build cantilevered and spurred scaffolds • Build sloping platforms including barrow ramps • Install cantilevered crane loading platforms • Install edge protection and covered access ways

CPCCLSF3001A License to erect, alter and dismantle scaffolding intermediate level PREREQUISITE: Basic Scaffolding

DOGMAN (DG) - 5 DAYS

LOCATION: Werribee or Onsite

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Undertake a range of slinging techniques • Select and inspect lifting gear and equipment • Direct crane operators in the safe movement and placement of loads • Communicate with whistles, hand signals and use of fixed two-way radios

CPCCLDG3001A Licence to perform dogging

RIGGING (RB) - 5 DAYS

LOCATION: Werribee or Onsite

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Undertake steel erection • Erect Hoists • Placement of pre-cast concrete • Install cantilever crane loading platforms

CPCCLRG3001A Licence to perform rigging basic level PREREQUISITE: Dogging

NON-SLEWING CRANE (CN) - 3 DAYS

LOCATION: Werribee or Onsite

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Operate a Non-Slewing Crane including all functions to maximum extension, lifting and moving of loads
- Assess ground conditions • Interpret crane specifications including load charts to enable the crane to be configured for loads
- Use communication techniques including whistles, hand signals and two way radios

TLILIC3006 Licence to operate a non-slewing mobile crane *GREATER THAN 3 TONNE

ELEVATED WORK PLATFORM (WP) - 2 DAYS

LOCATION: Werribee or Onsite

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Planning out work • Conduct routine checks • Set up and operate elevating work platform • Identify hazards and assess risks associated with operation • Understand characteristics, technical capabilities and limitations of equipment • Shut down and secure elevating work platform

TLILIC2005 Licence to operate a boom-type elevated work platform *OVER 11 METRES (BOOM)

MATERIALS HOIST (HM) - 1 DAY

LOCATION: Werribee or Onsite

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Operate a materials hoist (builders hoist) for goods and materials • Record and maintain information relating to material hoist operations • Communicate effectively using bells, lights and hand signals • Identify hazards and assess risks associated with operating the materials hoist

CPCCLHS3002A Licence to operate a materials hoist

FORKLIFT (LF) - 2 DAYS

LOCATION: Werribee or Onsite

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Operate a forklift truck • Check and assess operational capabilities of equipment • Move and place a variety of loads
- Understand forklift characteristics and capabilities

When the assessor deems you competent, you are issued with a Notice of Assessment which you must lodge at a Post Office within 60 days to obtain your license from Worksafe Victoria. This incurs a \$64 fee to WorkSafe Victoria.
