The construction induction card also known as a white card is a mandatory requirement for all workers on building and civil construction sites. This course is aimed at giving participants the basic principles of occupational health and safety requirements.

Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:

- Report construction hazards and risks
- Discuss OHS issues and information
- Identify common construction hazards
- Understand basic principles of risk management
