### DOGGING (DG) - 5 DAYS

LOCATION: Geelong & Werribee

In this course you will learn the skills required to perform slinging techniques, including the selection and inspection of lifting gear and directing of the crane operator. Successful completion of this course will provide you with your WorkSafe high risk dogging licence.

**Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:**

- Understand communication techniques such as whistles, hand signals and use of fixed two-way radios
- Calculate capacity of lifting equipment
- Understand slinging techniques in a variety of conditions
- Select and inspect lifting equipment
- Understand work instructions
- Direct crane operators in the moving of loads
- Identify hazards and assess risks associated with operation

- Understand work instructions
- Erect hoists
- Identify hazards and assess risks associated with operation

### INTERMEDIATE RIGGING (RI) - 4 DAYS

LOCATION: Geelong

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to safely perform intermediate rigging work. Successful completion of this course will provide you with your WorkSafe high risk intermediate rigging licence

**Upon successful completion participants will have the ability to:**

- Identify workplace and task-specific hazards and determine required risk controls
- Identify required rigging equipment and associated gear
- Calculate loads associated with mechanical load shifting equipment
- Erect and dismantle all structures and operate plant while maintaining stability, in accordance with workplace and manufacturer requirements.
- Conduct a multiple-crane lift.
- Erect and dismantle a tower crane section or a crane lattice boom section.
- Lift and install a series of tilt-up concrete panels

RIIHAN210D - Perform intermediate rigging operations

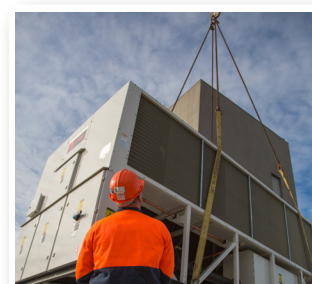
**ASSESSMENT METHOD:** Written activities, verbal questions, observation and practical demonstration

**OBTAINING YOUR LICENCE:** The licence to perform High Risk Work is issued by WorkSafe Victoria. When the assessor deems you competent, you will need to lodge your licence application and Notice of Assessment within 60 days to obtain a high risk work licence. You can now apply, renew or amend a high risk work licence online at: [www.myworksafe.vic.gov.au](http://www.myworksafe.vic.gov.au) You will receive an email from myWorkSafe that contains your Training ID. The email will contain a link that allows you to download the Notice of Assessment (NOA) to enable you to lodge your licence application. All licence applications incur a fee payable to WorkSafe Victoria.
